Budgeting, Forecasting and Cost Control is a 5-day senior-level planning and control course delivered by Mars Training Centre UK in London, Dubai, Barcelona, Kuala Lumpur, Cairo and online — designed for finance directors, controllers, and senior business leaders responsible for the planning cycle and the discipline that sits behind it.

The annual budget cycle has been under quiet attack for two decades. Static budgets age badly in volatile markets, rolling forecasts demand new disciplines, and zero-based and driver-based approaches require different skills from the team that produces them. The leaders who run this cycle well give their organisations a decisive operating advantage; those who do not spend the year explaining variances no one wants to hear.

Across five focused days, you will work through budget design, forecasting methods, cost-control techniques, variance analysis at executive level, and the conversations that turn a planning cycle into a performance management system. The cases are drawn from the United Kingdom, Europe, and the Middle East, and the work is delivered by senior practitioners with planning and FP&A experience.

- Design a budget process that supports rather than distorts strategic execution.
- Build a rolling forecast that produces useful early signal.
- Apply zero-based, activity-based, and driver-based budgeting approaches.
- Evaluate cost structures and identify the right targets for control.
- Analyse variances and communicate them with credibility.
- Run a disciplined budget challenge process across business units.
- Connect the budget to operational KPIs and balanced scorecards.
- Lead a finance team through the annual budget cycle.
- Defend budget recommendations to executive committees and boards.
- Build a culture of accountability around budget commitments.
