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Strategic Procurement and Sourcing is a five-day senior procurement course delivered by Mars Training Centre at our international venues — including London, Dubai, Amsterdam, Geneva, and Kuala Lumpur — designed for procurement directors, heads of sourcing, and category leaders responsible for high-value spend.

Procurement has moved a long way from the purchase-order function it once was. That requires a strategic operating model, not a transactional one, and it requires senior procurement leaders who can think and act at executive level.

Across five focused days, you will move from a spend-mapping diagnostic into the disciplines that separate strategic procurement from operational buying — category strategy, sourcing strategy selection, total cost of ownership, supplier segmentation, and the build-versus-buy decision. The week is delivered by senior practitioners who have led procurement organisations in industry. You leave with a personal action plan grounded in your own categories and spend profile.

- Construct a make-versus-buy analysis for a critical category.
- Embed sustainability, risk, and innovation criteria into sourcing decisions.
- Build the business case for a strategic procurement transformation.
- Lead a category review with cross-functional stakeholders.
- Translate procurement results into board-level language.
