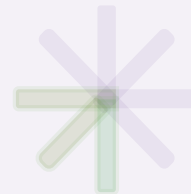

The cases are drawn from the United Kingdom, Europe, and the Middle East, and the work is delivered by senior practitioners with energy-leadership experience at the most senior levels of the industry.
