Employee Engagement and Retention

Employee Engagement and Retention is a five-day senior HR course delivered by Mars Training Centre in London, Amsterdam, Dubai, Cairo, and Jakarta — designed for heads of engagement, employee-experience leaders, and senior HR professionals responsible for keeping critical talent and improving the working experience of the workforce.

For two decades, engagement has been measured everywhere and managed in too few places. Survey scores are produced annually, dashboards circulate, and action plans are written, yet senior leaders frequently report that engagement work feels disconnected from the things employees actually care about. Meanwhile, retention has become a board-level concern as the cost of losing critical employees climbs and the labour market remains tight in skill-scarce sectors.

Across five focused days, you will move from the theory of engagement to the practice of building an engagement and retention agenda that earns its place on the executive committee. The programme is delivered by senior practitioners who have led engagement and experience functions through transformations, mergers, and difficult cycles.

- Design and run a credible engagement-listening strategy.
- Interpret engagement data critically, including the difference between drivers and signals.
- Build evidence-based action plans that change the experience of work.
- Diagnose retention risk for critical roles and populations.
- Apply structured retention interventions, including stay conversations.
- Design and govern an employee value proposition that earns trust.
- Coach line managers as the primary owners of engagement and retention.
- Make a credible business case for engagement investment to the executive team.
